### The Bible: (our pursuit of clarity)

\*Genesis 1:27 - "So God created man in his own image; he created him in the image of God; he created them male and female."

God is "pro-life" - ALL life because He is the creator of it. God creates us in His image, unique and with purpose, and it's through that uniqueness that we fulfill our purpose - to glory God - through that uniqueness. God says that in the womb we have uniqueness and purpose.....

\*Also, this is an issue where the Bible and science actually agree.

### **The Science:**

5 weeks: (as early as)

The heart starts beating

#### 8 weeks:

- suck their thumbs
- respond to sound
- Evidence that they are dreaming
- Recoil from pain (doctors use a needle to pull blood from the fetus he/she will pull it's heal up) (20 weeks women are given painkillers for an abortion not for them but for the baby)
- Nervous system and a brain that receives signals
- All major organs are functioning
- Heart is pumping
- The liver is making blood cells
- Kidneys are clearing fluid
- There is a fingerprint

#### 21 weeks:

- With a little help the baby can survive outside of the womb
- Nearly all of the 1 million abortions committed in North America last year.....happened after 21 weeks.

## **3-D sonogram:** (technology - it helps!)

- Watch our babies smile at us
- **BUT...Is it a person?** Even if both sides, the right and the left/pro-life and pro-choice, concede a little.....and leave the debate saying it might be a person.....is that enough to kill it? I heard an excellent illustration pertaining to that: \*hunting

with a friend.....hear a rustling in the bushes....it might be a deer, it might be your friend.....do you take the shot???

Dr. Warren Hern, author of Abortion Practice—to a Planned
Parenthood conference: "We have reached a point in this particular
technology where there is no possibility of denying an act of
destruction. It is before one's eyes. The sensations of dismemberment
flow through the forceps like an electric current."

We don't need anymore evidence to prove that this is a human being....a person alive in the womb. There is NO MORE evidence needed!

## And yet....abortion still exists.

But to add to that:

- Stalin killed 40 million of his own countrymen
- Hitler killed 30 million human beings
- In the US, since Roe vs Wade in 1973, there have been 55 million abortions....in the US alone.

In Switzerland: Cooking live lobsters are banned because they feel pain (scream) when they are boiled live.

It is <u>illegal</u> to harm, harass, or **kill** any sea **turtles**, their **eggs**, or hatchlings.

#### **Planned Parenthood:**

Millions of people face unplanned pregnancies every year, and about 4 out of 10 of them decide to get an abortion. Overall, 1 in 4 women in the U.S. will have an abortion by the time they're 45 years old.

Some of the many different reasons people decide to end a pregnancy include:

• They want to be the best parent possible to the kids they already have.

# And yet...abortion still exists.

"It is wrong to intentionally kill an innocent human being. Abortion intentionally kills an innocent human being.

Therefore, abortion is wrong." (Scott Klusendorf, *president of Life Training Institute*)

So therefore it is not about the debate. It is not about whether the fetus is a person or not - I think this next quote will give us some insight... "Yet I know that throughout my own pregnancies, I never wavered for a moment in the belief that I was carrying a human life inside of me. I believe that's what a fetus is: a human life. And that doesn't make me one iota less solidly pro-choice. Here's the complicated reality in which we live: All life is not equal. That's a difficult thing for liberals like me to talk about, lest we wind up looking like death-panel-loving, kill-your-grandma-and-your-precious-baby storm troopers. Yet a fetus can be a human life without having the same rights as the woman in whose body it resides. She's the boss. Her life and what is right for her circumstances and her health should automatically trump the rights of the non-autonomous entity inside of her. Always."

\*The baby has its own DNA, it's own genetic code, it's own blood type, has its own functioning brain, functioning kidneys, it's own functioning lungs - IT'S NOT THE WOMAN'S BODY.....IT'S ITS OWN!

\*if someone you cared about called you and said they were thinking of commiting suicide (thoughts) what would you say? "Think about how this will affect me and other people around this person's life **OR** rather should say that God has created you with passion, and uniqueness, and purpose."

Ultimately, the most controversial part of all these 3 weeks is not sexuality, gender, or abortion. It's submitting to the authority of God. **God is the authority! He, and He alone determines value!**

Someone, some hierarchy of art counsel, deems this painting worth \$10,000. That's crazy to me! Some guy just painted 2 cardboard boxes and then stuck a piece of gauze, new or used, in the corner. I would say it's worth \$10....maybe.

But....it's worth isn't determined by me. I don't decide what this piece of...art is worth. Because I don't decide what it's worth then the artist doesn't care what I think it's worth.

Because someone higher, the arts council or dealers (whatever), has determined its value. It doesn't matter what Todd thinks.....I don't determine someone's value.

It's the same with the abortion issue. God is that "something higher" and He, and He alone, determines a person's value....both in the womb and out of the womb:

## **Practical steps:**

**Be discipled!:** Have the courage to say what we know.....not what we think.

**Disciple others:** Psalm 78:5-7 - "He established a testimony in Jacob and set up a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers to teach to their children so that a future generation—**children yet to be born**—might know. They were to rise and tell their children so that they might put their confidence in God and not forget God's works, but keep his commands."

**Go Visual:** show the reality, cause people to think. "Many people dislike abortion images and find them offensive. That's to be expected, given the discomfort of admitting moral culpability in the face of injustice. The more pressing question is whether the number of people put off by the graphic images exceeds those compelled into modifying their beliefs." (Scott Klusendorf - TGC)

**Never, ever forget the women who are involved:** having an abortion is not the unforgivable sin. Where sins abounds, grace abounds all the more.

We need to be compassionate advocates..."Almost half of the women who procure abortions are living under the federal poverty line—and many cite financial scarcity as their primary reason for getting an abortion. Understanding this strain, and helping address it, should be an integral part of the pro-life cause—not just on a political level, but on a cultural and grassroots level. It should be a natural extension of the pro-life cause, which is determined to fight for the most vulnerable among us." (Gracy Olmstead - TGC)

#### Mark 10:46-52;

"46 They came to Jericho.   - Let's not get caught up arguing/debating with people who are (as Paul says to Timothy), "people whose minds are depraved and deprived of the truth..."
  - May our loudest voice be to Jesus for his help and interference.
  - Yes....let's write letters to our MP's. Advocate in the public forum where we can. Let's discuss the facts and show the science BUT most importantly we need to be a praying people on this issue.
  - Pray about it in every prayer!
